They are available to all patients at standard OMA rates

<p><b>Physical exam requested by a third party (this type of examination is covered by OHIP in certain circumstances). We would be pleased to review these circumstances with you at the time the service is requested. This type of examination is insured when medically necessary AND if it relates to any of the following:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Receiving disability or sickness benefits or requirements in a policy or contract dealing with disability or sickness benefits.</li> <li>2. Return to a day-care or preschool program after a temporary absence</li> <li>3. Certain requirements regarding fitness to continue employment</li> <li>4. An absence from or return to work.</li> <li>5. Legal proceedings</li> </ol>

\*\*\* Driver's Medical and other third party examinations are uninsured services. The fee listed will be reduced by 50% for those who pay the Annual Fee.
